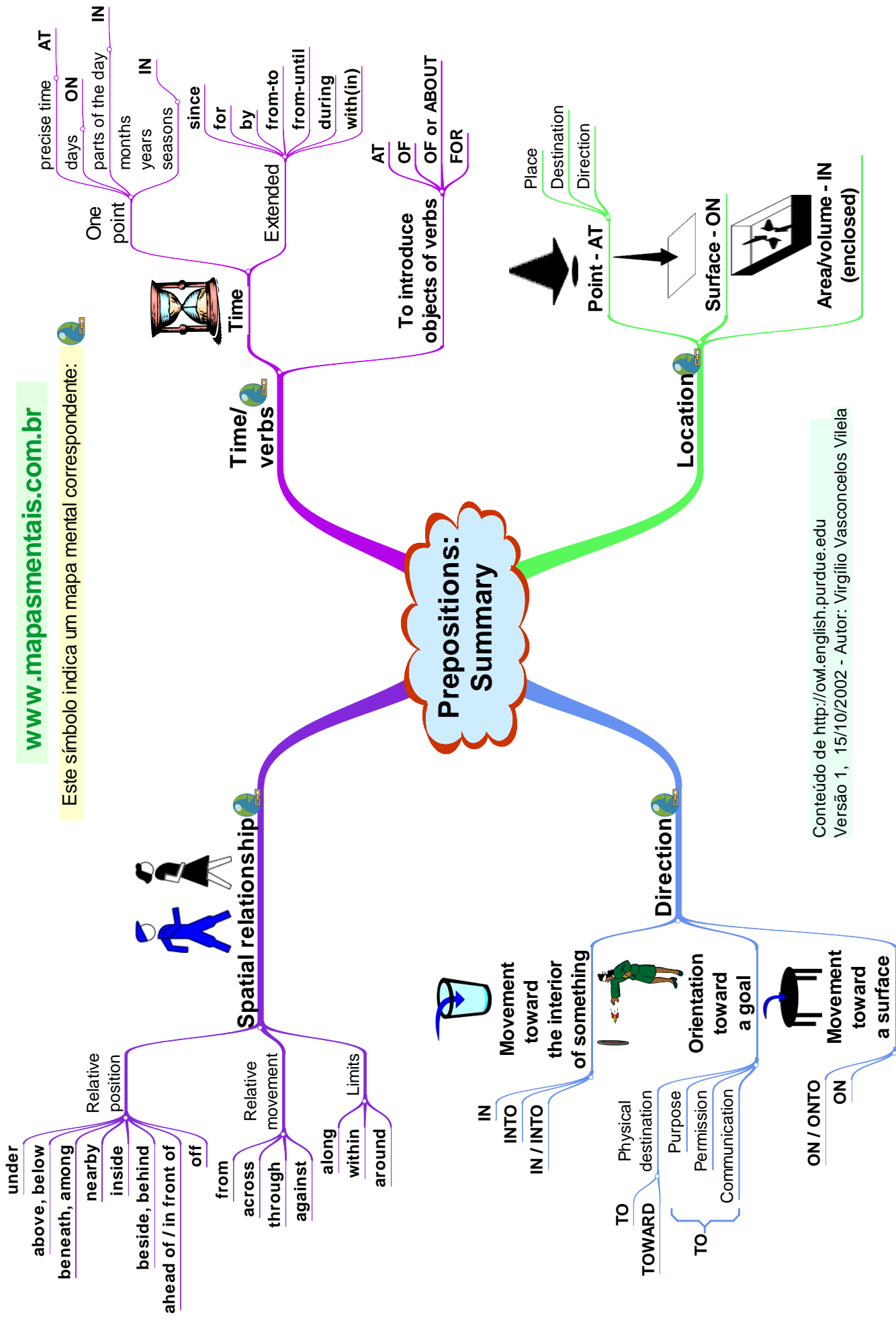
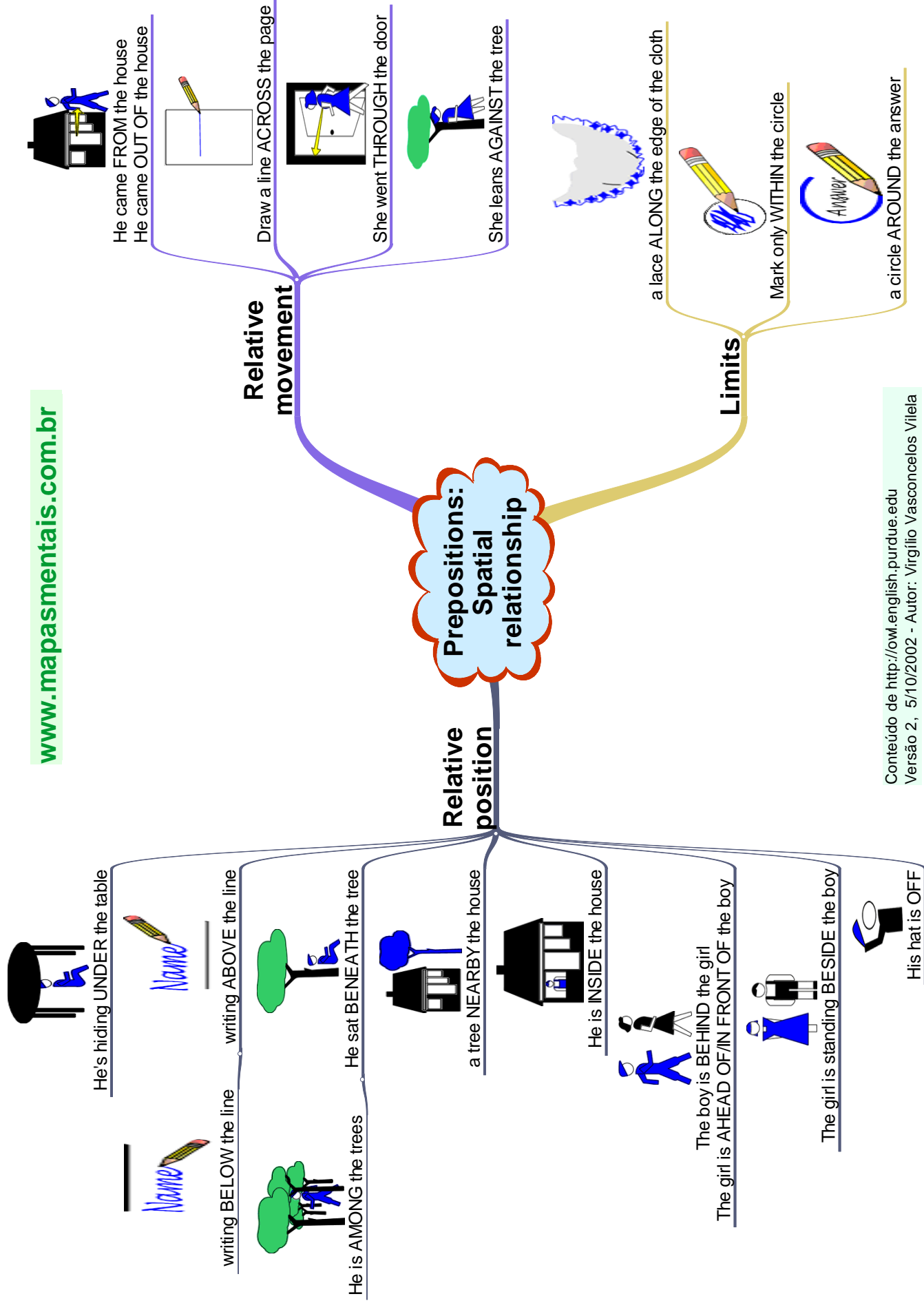


Este símbolo indica um mapa mental correspondente:







## Time

### One point

- precise time **AT** My plane leaves **AT** noon.
- days **ON** The movie starts **AT** 6 p.m.
- I will see you **ON** Monday.
- parts of the day **IN** I will see you **IN** the afternoon.
- months, years, seasons **IN** The days are long **IN** August.
- The book will be published **IN** 2003.
- The flowers will bloom **IN** spring.

### Extended

- SINCE** She has been gone **SINCE** yesterday.
- FOR** I'm going to Paris **FOR** two weeks.
- BY** New president to be named **BY** Monday.
- 11 new cars will be introduced **BY** 2003.
- FROM-TO** The movie showed **FROM** August **TO** October.
- FROM-UNTIL** The decorations were up **FROM** spring **UNTIL** fall.
- DURING** I watch tv **DURING** the evening.
- WITH(IN)** We must finish the project **WITHIN** a year.

## Prepositions: Time/verbs

### To introduce objects of verbs

- AT**
  - She took a quick **GLANCE AT** her reflection. Exception: a glance **IN** the mirror
  - You didn't **LAUGH AT** his joke.
  - LOOK AT** the computer monitor.
  - We **REJOICED AT** his safe rescue.
  - That pretty girl **SMILED AT** you.
  - Stop **STARING AT** me.
  - I don't **APPROVE OF** his speech.
- OF**
  - My contribution to the article **CONSISTS OF** many pages.
  - He came home **SMELLING OF** alcohol.
- OF or ABOUT**
  - I **DREAM OF / ABOUT** finishing college in four years.
  - I am **THINKING OF / ABOUT** this problem.
  - Did someone **CALL FOR** a taxi?
  - He **HOPES FOR** a raise in salary.
  - I'm **LOOKING FOR** my keys.
  - We'll **WAIT FOR** her here.
- FOR**
  - Buy the tickets while I **WATCH FOR** the train.
  - I **WISH FOR** an "A" in this class.
